TEXAS ROLLERGIRLS JUNIOR LEAGUE SCHOLARSHIP



Texas Rollergirls Rock-n-Rollerderby® will provide a scholarship opportunity for one girl each session of the Texas Rollergirls Junior League. The scholarship will cover the registration fee for the session applied. Skaters may apply for the Texas Rollergirls Junior League Scholarship if the skater meets the eligibility requirements and returns the completed application prior to 3rd scheduled practice. The deadline for the scholarship this session is June 25, 2009. The scholarship recipient will be announced by the 4th practice, which is June 26, 2009. Please submit the scholarship application to a Texas Rollergirls Junior League Manager.

Eligibility Requirements

- Must demonstrate financial need (single parent income < \$30,000; household < \$50,000)
- Must have a “B” average over the previous academic year (if available)
- Must maintain a “B” average throughout the 10-week session
- Did not receive a Texas Rollergirls Junior League Scholarship for the previous session

Application Instructions

Applicants should write a one-page essay describing your interest in roller derby and how participating will benefit you. Essay must be typed or neatly hand-written. Essays will be judged on content and grammar.

Please answer the following essay questions:

1. Why am I interested in roller derby?
2. How will/can participating in roller derby positively impact me?

Nominees will receive consideration without discrimination of race, creed, color, sex, age, national origin, or disability status. Successful applicants will be expected to provide evidence of eligibility before funds are awarded.

Please be sure to submit the items listed below. Only complete applications submitted on or before the due date will be reviewed.

1. Copy of parent/guardian’s tax record stating the household annual income
2. Copy of skater’s previous school year report card
3. One-page essay written by skater

Latest report card during the 10-week session needs to be submitted to Texas Rollergirls Junior League Manager before the last practice in order for the skater to be eligible for the next available scholarship opportunity. Awarded skaters cannot receive the scholarship in two consecutive sessions but is welcomed to apply for the scholarship every session.
